


Installation and Care of SP-13 Recessed Soap Dish

<u>Warning</u>: This product is ligature-resistant only when properly installed. A loosened fixture can easily be tied to. Any product which can be removed can be used as a weapon!

Front Mount Installation:

- 1. Cut a 6.5" x 5" x 2.75" (minimum) rough opening in the wall.
- 2. Secure to the wall using fasteners¹ through the 3/16"mounting holes in the flanges. Refer to the diagram below for mounting hole locations. Use anchors as appropriate to ensure a structurally sound attachment. (Anchors and fasteners not included.)



3. Verify that the recessed soap dish cannot be loosened or removed. Fill any gaps between the wall and the flange with a security sealant (such as Pecora Dynapoxy EP-1200). Verify that no gaps exist between the wall and the grab bar that can accommodate a tie.

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¹ Security fasteners are strongly recommended. The selection of a particular size and type of security fastener should be made in conjunction with a facility manager, because it depends upon factors such as construction materials and institutional standards.



Care and Maintenance:

- -SS (Satin Stainless Steel Finish):
 - Clean with soft rag and mild detergent. Do not use caustic or abrasive cleaners.
 - If discoloration occurs, use 3M Stainless Steel Cleaner and Polish with a soft cloth or Scotch Brite.
- -WA (White Antimicrobial Powder Coat Finish):
 - Clean with mild detergent and a non-abrasive cloth. Aggressive cleaning techniques may remove the finish. Do not use abrasive cleaners or chemical solvents.
 - Seal any chips, cracks, or scratches in the powder coating with clear nail polish to prevent future peeling or flaking.
